

Provost Linda Seestedt-Stanford has brought to my attention the fact that some incorrect information was included in Budget Update No. 6. First, please allow me to apologize for this unfortunate matter. The Provost has shared the following information with those in the Division of Academic Affairs, and I thought it important to make the entire campus aware:

“The update inadvertently stated that reorganization had occurred in **Enrollment Management** resulting in the elimination of several positions. The reorganization was actually in **Undergraduate Studies**. Three positions were eliminated in the Division of Undergraduate Studies because of a consolidation of two academic success centers (the Catamount Academic Tutoring Center and the Writing Center) and a restructuring of Career Services functions. Other realignments within Undergraduate Studies also are being considered. In addition to the above restructuring, the Academic Success Program (ASP) has moved from Enrollment Management to Undergraduate Studies – First Year Experience. There also have been some changes in the Coulter Faculty Commons. One position was eliminated and two positions were reorganized for salary savings in that restructuring process.”

Again, I regret any concern caused by incorrect information in the recent campus update. I do understand that the times we are in are stressful enough without inadvertently adding to the anxiety through an inaccuracy. I will continue to provide updated information as the situation changes, and to be sure those updates are accurate and timely.
