Sports Events

The Washington Redskins win their third Super Bowl title over the Buffalo Bills, 37-24.
The Toronto Blue Jays become the first Canadian team to play in a World Series and the first non-American team to win the World Series.
Chicago Bulls win NBA Championship 4 games to 2 over the Portland Trail Blazers.
Fred Couples wins the Masters Tournament.
The Summer and Winter Olympics are held for the last time in the same year, after 1992 each alternate every two years.
Brett Favre makes his first start for the Green Bay Packers.
